

VCE 3&4 – Tamil Language 2026

Rules, Rights & Responsibilities

This document outlines key VCE rules about eligibility, assessment, extensions, appeals, special provision, and N/J results. You must read this document carefully and keep it for reference. You should speak to your teacher or the VCE coordinator if you need clarification or help.

1. VCE Eligibility

To receive your VCE, you must complete the required number of units set by the VCAA. Tamil language is only one subject, and it form part of your VCE study, and you will be taking other subjects to complete your VCE.

2. Academic Integrity for SACs (Tamil language)

All work must be your own.

Do NOT copy, share work with others, or get unfair help.

You must sign an authentication declaration when you are asked to do so.

Breaches can result in an N or further penalties.

3. Extensions

If you need extra time:

- Contact your teacher ASAP.
- Apply using school process with evidence.
- Extension granted only for valid reasons (e.g. illness)

4. Appeals

You can appeal decisions (results, N, extensions).

- Submit in writing on time
- Your case will be reviewed
- Outcome provided in writing

5. Special Provision

Available for illness or personal issues affecting study.

- Apply through your coordinator or VCE Teacher
- Provide evidence
- School decides adjustments, and it is final.

6. N and J Results

- N = Not Satisfactory
 - J = Interrupted Studies
- Key points:
- You may get chances to redeem outcomes
 - SAC scores don't change
 - Too many Ns can affect VCE completion

Rule Breaches

If suspected:

- You'll be informed and you will be given the opportunity to respond
- Investigation will occur
- You'll receive the outcome and you can appeal, if you think the decision is unfair

Key Tips

- Read task instructions carefully, ask for clarification if necessary.
- Meet deadlines
- Attend classes
- Ask for help early
